Brewery Creek – Have You Heard?

Hopefully by now you have heard that after many years of waiting and working, it is now time for the Brewery Creek Mine to move towards reopening. It is with great excitement that we received the confirmation from the Yukon Government of the certainty to reopen the mine as licensed under our current Water License and Quartz Mining License. Golden Predator did a great deal of due diligence on the licenses and presented the information to Tr'ondëk Hwech'in (TH) which provided clear support for a restart. Now that doesn't mean there will not be amendments needed over time and TH and the community will be involved in any reviews. So expect to see us around a lot more often and keep your eyes open for community information as we move along.

With that support comes great responsibility (yes...I have just quoted Spiderman) and we respect the need to meet high standards for community involvement, job performance, environmental management and safe operations. And I expect we will have some growing pains but the opportunity to bring the Brewery Creek Mine, which served the community well in the past, back to life is truly exciting.

The Brewery Creek Mine is located about a 45 minute drive from Dawson, located at the end of the North Fork Road (built for the mine operations) off the Dempster Highway. It operated from 1996 to 2002 and closed due to low gold prices. The operating permits and licenses were kept in place for a timely restart when the market conditions improved. Brewery Creek is the best Yukon example of a mine that was built, operated and temporarily reclaimed and now the cycle continues and it is our plan to maintain these high standards on an environmentally and economically proven project.

Brewery Creek was the 1st sub-Arctic heap leach mine in the world and the model for future heap leach mines in the North

1996 – 2002 – Viceroy operated the mine, 60% of all employees lived in the Yukon

2009 – 2012 - Golden Predator spent \$30mm increasing the gold resource at Brewery Creek

2012 Golden Predator and Tr'ondëk Hwëch'in sign Socio Economic Accord

2019 – Restart of Brewery Creek Mine under existing licenses approved by Yukon Government – not possible without the support of TH
